1 in 10 women have experienced some form of sexual violence since the age of 15.


1 in 20 women have been victims of rape

Almost 2 in 5 women have been victims of physical and/or sexual violence inflicted by their current or former partner.


Almost 2 in 10 women have experienced some form of sexual violence by an adult before the age of 15.






Women who have been sexually harassed since age 15




Women victims of rape




Women who have experienced sexual/physical violence (of which 22% by their partner)






Sample of 16,600 women from 22 European countries:
