#### **Survey UN - UNICEF 2020**



1 in 3 students, aged 13-15, have experienced bullying



Between 5% an 20% of the youth population (under 18) in the main industrialised countries have experienced cyberbullying, with psychophysical consequences

Children and adolescents suffer some form of bullying or cyberbullying around the world every year.








